



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 1588**

The Municipal District of Willow Creek No. 26 Council Chambers

PURSUANT to sections 230, 606, and 692 of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, Chapter M-26, 2000, as amended, the Council of the Municipal District of Willow Creek No. 26 in the Province of Alberta hereby gives notice of its intention to consider Bylaw No. 1588, being a bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 1250, being the municipal Land Use Bylaw.

THE PURPOSE of the proposed Bylaw No. 1588 is to redesignate the subject lands from "Rural General - RG" to "Rural Recreational - RR" to accommodate the subdivision of 40 acres from the existing 160 acres for recreational use. The lands that are the subject of the proposed land use district redesignation are located within a portion of SE 2-11-28-4 as shown on the map in Schedule 'A' and are legally described as:
