**PURSUANT** to sections 230, 606, and 692 of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, Chapter M-26, 2000, as amended, the Council of the Municipal District of Willow Creek No. 26 in the Province of Alberta hereby gives notice of its intention to consider Bylaw No. 1632, being a bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 1616, being the municipal Land Use Bylaw.

**THE PURPOSE** of the proposed Bylaw No. 1632 is to redesignate the subject lands from "Rural General – RG" to "Vacant Country Residential - VCR" in order to accommodate the subdivision of 5 acres of bare land from 79.78 acres for country residential use. The lands that are the subject of the proposed land use district redesignation are located within a portion of SE 28-9-24-4 as shown on the map in Schedule 'A' and are legally described as:
